



Who Engages in Mind Control?

- Magical religions which connect worship with sexual violence and ritual murder and believe they are causing demon possession in children they abuse
- Secret societies
- Neo-Nazis, the KKK and other right-wing groups
- American and other military and intelligence agencies ("black ops")
- Traditional organized crime: child prostitution and pornography, human trafficking, drug smuggling
- They all use the same children. Follow the connections.

Public Discrediting of Therapists and Survivors

- In the 1990s articles in all printed media suggested that therapists implant false memories in people who allege such events.
- There were "False memory" lawsuits against the first therapist leaders in this field.
- Websites mix truths about this very real abuse with ridiculous disinformation.

Psychologically Sophisticated Organized Child Abuse

- Begins with a child who isn't permitted to bond with the mother or father, so there is no secure attachment bond. Betrayal and abandonment and sexual abuse by parents cement this situation.
- Mind control "Programmers" know brain science and child development.
- They use torture (electroshock, drowning and waterboarding, rape, etc.) to create complex dissociative disorders (the old term was "multiple personality") in children, who grow up split into many parts.
- Victims are deceived into believing many unbelievable things through indoctrination, impersonation, and stage magic.

Definitions

Mind control is abuse of children (and adults) by an organized group which deliberately creates, indoctrinates, and trains internal parts (alter personalities) to do its bidding.

- Deliberate creation of inside parts in infancy
- Creation of a planned structured personality system
- Victims are not supposed to know about their hidden parts
- Creation of inner structures and/or an inner world where parts "live"
- Beliefs are implanted and parts trained to do their jobs through torture, drugs, training and stage magic.

Ritual abuse is mind control by a religious group.

Ritually Abusive Groups

- Ritual abusers do all the things you've heard they do—black masses, ritual murder, orgies—but they are not all just Satanists; they believe in a variety of evil spiritual beings.
- Satanism and Luciferianism are (hidden) religions. They operate in covens of 13 "adult" members and their families.
- They observe both Christian and pagan holy days.
- Covens are connected to larger cult groups with regional and often international structures.
- There are large gatherings where people are sacrificed, followed by orgies. Dates are predictable.
- Only members born into the religion can join the inner circle; those who join in adulthood are only used as watchers or hit men or bullies.

Locations

- Small ritual gatherings are conducted in members' homes and churches. 10 to 30 groups in a city.
- Large gatherings happen in cemeteries, churches, isolated forest clearings, neighborhoods where they own all the houses, large mansions, and enclosed compounds. Outdoor rituals have guards posted in the trees, and the police officer patrolling the area is one of their own.
- Survivors report military/political groups torturing them on operating tables in hospitals and in black chairs wired with electricity at various military sites.

Real Life Jobs of Members

- As with child sex offenders, group members are designated to enter professions where they can help the group: police, therapists, psychiatrists, doctors, teachers, owners of daycare centers, clergy, mental hospital staff, filmmakers, theater managers, photographers, delivery drivers.
- Members' socio-economic status tends to parallel their level of authority in the cult.

Forced Perpetration

- Rituals involve rape, animal sacrifice, human sacrifice (both real and simulated).
- Victims include: unregistered children and babies, runaways, street people.
- Simulated killing is usually of people with known identities, to discredit survivors who remember.
- Every member has to perpetrate. Children stab with an adult hand around their hand.
- Law enforcement can't infiltrate because of forced perpetration and because only those born into it can get deeper than the fringes.

Child Trafficking

- Every survivor I've known or know about, male or female, has been used in child prostitution and pornography.
- Ritual and KKK murders are filmed.
- Kids are trained at "cult camps" during school holidays.
- Children are trained in sadism, masochism, bestiality, necrophilia, and having their sexual responses conditioned to violence.
- Child prostitutes have parts who specialize in whatever sexual skill the client wants.
- Kids used *only* for the sex trade may not have extensive other kinds of programming or training, other than for silencing.
- Many or most participants in S & M groups may be survivors.
- Cult members are not supposed to sexually abuse kids outside the group. They attend rituals in order to satisfy sexual needs created by the group.

Mind Control Programming

"Programming is the act of installing internal, pre-established reactions to external stimuli so that a person will automatically react in a predetermined manner to things like an auditory, visual or tactile signal, or perform a specific set of actions according to a date and/or time."

There is only one way to create persons who can engage in rape, ritual murder, spying, sex slavery, or assassination without any conscious awareness of this. The way is through abuse and torture of small children, separating parts of their minds that are then indoctrinated and trained individually as the abusers see fit.

Trained child parts do their jobs in fear of death or torture to themselves or others if they disobey.

Some Important Jobs of Parts

- Many or most inside parts (including young child parts) have specialized "jobs" in which they have been trained.
- Some jobs are always to be done; other jobs are to be done in response to certain types of events in the inner or outer world.
- Some child parts memorize and respond to deliberately placed touch, sound or sight "triggers" or signals for bringing out specific inside parts or giving instructions.
- Switch controllers turn "programs" on and off by internal switches and buttons which have specific effects, like putting parts to sleep or making them suicidal or creating hallucinations.
- Punishers create various symptoms of mental illness as punishments for making disclosures.

Parts who Maintain Group Contact
("Access programming")

- **Reporting** parts report disclosures & relocations to the perpetrators.
- **Returning** parts have to return to the group on significant dates.
- Parts who **"come when called"** respond to access triggers (answer the phone, open the door, cross the street because of hand signal).

Slide 14

Why Kids Won't Talk

- There is extensive training not to tell.
- Kids see someone being tortured and apparently killed, and are told it's because he was a "traitor" who told about what happened, so they had better not be a traitor.
- Kids who even show pain or distress at school, leading the school to contact the parents, are severely punished by the parents.
- Victims are told that the group knows everything they do and say, and that if they talk someone they love will be killed.
- Kids are taken by someone in a police uniform to a cell where the officer or another apparent prisoner beat the kids up. If they disclose anything they are told by the fake cop that they are being charged with murder, they are the real criminals, and they will be kept in this cell for ever.
- They are taken to cult-involved "therapists" and doctors, who ask them what happened, triggers them to tell, then rape them.
- Doctors of cult members are cult members.
- A child needs to be in safe foster care for a long time before s/he will disclose. If the child is to be returned home, disclosure results in very severe punishment.

The BIG LIE abusers tell kids:

"We know everything and are all-powerful. We have magical (for young children) or technological (for older children) ways of knowing what you think and do and say."

- The walls have ears.
- Satan's eyes/the All-Seeing Eye watch you.
- We live in the shadows or in the walls.
- The crows/squirrels/spiders report to us.
- Your stuffed animals report to us.
- A microchip/device implanted in your body tell us where you are and what you are thinking/saying.
- A bomb in your body will go off if you are disloyal.
- Everyone you know is linked to us and will report to us.
- God/Lucifer/Satan (who is omnipotent, omniscient, and omni-present) is always watching you.

All these things are simulated in childhood, using hidden microphones, one-way mirrors, fake surgeries, and other deceptions. It's all tricks. Therapists, say to your clients:
If the abusers know everything about you, why would they need to tell you they know?

Other Problems with Interviewing

- Every survivor has a dissociative disorder. This means that in most cases the "front person" (presenting personality) doesn't know what the other parts know, and doesn't remember even current cult events. They can't tell because they really don't remember.
- Narratives may not read logically, as personalities may switch when a story is being told.
- A survivor from a distant location may begin to feel safe enough to talk, as long as their identity won't be disclosed to members of the perpetrator group. But most investigations require talking to family members, and the family will then send people to harass and threaten the person who talked.
- Survivors have inner snitches—personalities whose job is to report to the perpetrator group if the survivor told anything about the group to an outsider.

Internal Punishment for Disclosures

Self-harm, suicide attempts, apparent seizures, painful body memories, nightmares and flashbacks are triggered to occur if a mind-control survivor breaks the abusers' rules. Most of these symptoms are caused by inside parts whose job is to release portions of traumatic memories such as despair or pain or terrifying sights or shame for perpetrating.

Two Major Mistakes of Therapists

Helping one side of the personality system battle with the other side (fostering internal splitting instead of resolving internal conflicts)	Not recognizing that survivor's flooding of feelings or flashbacks or suicide attempts or self-harm are deliberately created by inside parts doing their assigned jobs

This definitely makes things worse!

Slow down to Stabilize

- Work your way up the system hierarchy by treating all parts with kindness.
- Establish rapport with internal leaders (those identified with the perpetrating group).
- Show internal leaders, and those continuing contact with perpetrators, how they were deceived.
- Delay memory work until those in charge inside are ready to permit it.

Working with the Hierarchy

- Reach out with compassion towards increasingly higher levels.
- Talk to those who give threats or punishments such as pain.
- Be gentle with curiosity; don't interrogate or confront.
- Ask ages but not names.
- Demonstrate understanding of jobs.
- Tell them you're an outsider (if you are) and ask about what they've been told about outsiders.
- (If you're the front person talking with your own inside parts, you may have to apologize for neglecting or being mean to them.)
- Pacing is crucial; don't go too fast.
- Get to know each one until it is replaced by its boss or backup.
- Tell them you know that their trust has to be earned.
- Work to get them to think for themselves.

Dialogue Which Exposes the Deceptions

- Don't argue with them, join them, agree, point out where & how they are absolutely correct.
- You can ask (repeatedly) "Is that right? Huh. Who told you that?" or "Hmm. I wonder when was the first time you heard that statement?" or "Mmm. That's interesting. I wonder who on the outside of you says such things?" or even "You know, you weren't born with that belief, so how did you get that belief?"
- Stay objective, neutral, and matter of fact --and curious & interested and wanting to understand.
- Topics:
 - What they believe or were taught about outsiders like you
 - Why they believe the group owns them
 - Why they believe they have to obey
 - The truth of what they were taught
 - Safety, protection and freedom

Unmasking the Deceptions

- Demonstrate a similar trick, without abuse. E.g. a mirror with something covering it.
- Write on one part's hand then show it to another part who believes it's in a different body.
- Ask parts who know the truth to communicate it internally to those who don't.
- Have parts together view an event in which they had different parts (e.g. the one the rat was put inside, and the one the rat was taken out of).
- Continually update each part of the system about time and place.

The Stages of Therapy

- Initially, don't ask about memories but ask about the person's present-day experience.
- Look for signs of dissociative disorders, teach about how these work, and encourage inner communication.
- Talk with increasingly higher levels of authority within the personality system.
- Update each part on current life and age.
- Encourage parts to choose freedom from abusers and stop doing assigned jobs.
- Encourage internal communication to reveal the perpetrators' lies and tricks.
- Eventually work through the traumatic memories.

Making Spiritual Meaning

- Ritual abuse directs specific abuses at the victim's spiritual belief system involving simulation of God, Jesus, Satan, etc.—or other deities.
- All victims have a deep inner knowledge that what happened was wrong.
- Both survivors and their therapists question our faith in humanity and in a benevolent deity who is also all-powerful.
- Even if we believe in God, we have to conclude He (or She) does not micromanage people's lives.
- Perhaps we need a different theology from the abuser groups.
- Many survivors have had near-death experiences in which they "crossed over" and found something good.
- The best gift therapists can give our mind-controlled clients, along with compassion, is the freedom to determine their own meaning, beliefs and life purpose.
- Most survivors who persist with recovery want a greater purpose for their lives.
- That purpose may or may not involve telling their story or trying to stop abuses. They deserve the freedom to choose a life which is not about these experiences.
